HEADLICE CONTROL

NO-NIT POLICY. Any camper with nits will be sent home. It is requested that each camper resolve any headlice problems before attending camp. The local health depts. Will examine each child with parent's approval if lice is suspected. It is important that hair be combed out in detail to prevent re-infestation. Please have respect and contain exposure to other campers before registration.

NO PERSONAL COOLERS

- Counselors will provide a cabin cooler large enough for each camper to use. Soda, water, and Kool-aid are provided in adequate amounts at camp. Campers may bring drinks, but they will be placed in the cabin cooler.

PARENTAL VISITS

- Parents visits are **discouraged**. Parental visits interrupt the camp schedule and increase bouts of "home-sickness." The camp staff will notify you if a need arises.
